

**Graduate Student Association  
General Membership Meeting**

**October 26, 2015**

**Number of students in attendance: 54**

1. Members of the GSA Executive Committee introduced themselves to members present at the request of the membership.
2. President Christina Hillesheim discussed the following announcements:
  - a. Three Minute These (3MT) competition will be November 11-13 from 1 to 4 pm. Preparation workshops are available on November 2 from 1 to 3 pm in the library auditorium and November 4 from 8-9 am in McComas Hall rooms 214 and 228.
  - b. Upcoming meeting date: November 30<sup>th</sup>
3. President Christina Hillesheim discussed the service event for the month of October. Members who attended the first date were thanked for their participation. President Christina Hillesheim informed members that the second date is completely full but she will inform members if a spot opens up. The service event for the month of November is volunteering at the Salvation Army Store on November 21, 2015. Time slots are available for those who wish to participate.
4. President Christina Hillesheim discussed the service events GSA has sponsored. Canoe Day was a huge success with 30 graduate student volunteers and 150 participants.
