All deadlines are at 12:00 midnight unless otherwise stated.

August 16	Classes begin.
August 18	Last day to drop or add a course (3rd class day).*
August 23	Last day to register or add a course (6th class day) 5:00 p.m.
August 28 –	Apply online via MyState for December 2023 degree - \$50 fee
October 20	Graduate students must be currently enrolled to apply for graduation.
September 19	Last day to drop a course with a "W" grade (24th class day) 5:00 p.m. Please note that the tuition charges will still apply. *
September 27	Last day to withdraw for Term One (5 class days remaining)*
October 3 - 4	Classes end: Tuesday/Thursday Classes – October 3; Monday/Wednesday Classes – October 4
October 9	Final grades due 10:00 a.m.
October 20	Deadline to apply for December 2023 degree via MyState with \$50 fee.
	Graduate students must be currently enrolled to apply for graduation.
October 21 –	Late December 2023 Degree Application via MyState - \$50 fee plus \$100 late application fee.
November 27	Graduate students must be currently enrolled to apply for graduation.
November 3	Last day for initial submission of thesis/dissertation to the Library for December graduation.
November 27	Deadline (last day) to apply for December 2023 graduation via myState with \$50 fee plus \$100
	late application fee.
	Graduate students must be currently enrolled to apply for graduation.
November 29	Deadline for graduate students receiving incomplete grades in a previous semester to submit
	the coursework.
December 8	Last day for December 2023 degree applicants to pay account balance 3:00 p.m.

^{*}Drop – If you are choosing to drop one or more classes from a specific term* while still staying enrolled in at least one course. Dropping a course will result in a grade of "W" and tuition plus additional fees will be charged.

^{*}Withdrawal – If you are enrolled in a course/courses as of the first day of the term* and you decide not to attend, you are withdrawing from the term. A withdrawal will result in a grade of "W" and a percentage, if not all, tuition will be owed depending on the effective withdrawal date.
