Mini -Term Two - 2023

All deadlines are at 12:00 midnight unless otherwise stated.

Date	Description
August 28 – October 20	Apply online via MyState for December 2023 degree - \$50 fee Graduate students must be currently enrolled to apply for graduation.
October 5	Classes begin.
October 9	Last day to drop or add a course (3rd class day).
October 12 – 13	Fall Break – No Classes Scheduled (Dates Subject to Change)
October 20	Deadline to apply for December 2023 degree via MyState with \$50 fee Graduate students must be currently enrolled to apply for graduation.
October 21- November 27	Late December 2023 Degree Application via myState - \$50 fee plus \$100 late application fee. Graduate students must be currently enrolled to apply for graduation.
November 9	Last day to drop a course with a “W” grade (24th class day) 5:00 p.m. Please note that the tuition charges will still apply. *
November 17	Last day to withdraw for Term Two (5 class days remaining). *
November 22- November 24	Thanksgiving holiday – no classes held.
November 27	Deadline (last day) to apply for December 2023 graduation via myState with \$50 fee plus \$100 late application fee. Graduate students must be currently enrolled to apply for graduation.
November 27 – November 28	Classes end: Monday/Wednesday Classes – November 27; Tuesday/Thursday Classes – November 28
November 29	Deadline for graduate students receiving incomplete grades in a previous semester to submit the coursework.
December 8	Last day for December 2023 degree applicants to pay account balance 3:00 p.m.
December 11	Final grades due 10:00 a.m.

Drop – If you are choosing to drop one or more classes from a specific term while still staying enrolled in at least one course. Dropping a course will result in a grade of “W” and tuition plus additional fees will be charged.

Withdrawal – If you are enrolled in a course/courses as of the first day of the term and you decide not to attend, you are withdrawing from the term. A withdrawal will result in a grade of “W” and a percentage, if not all, tuition will be owed depending on the effective withdrawal date.
