April 16	Last day to drop a course with a "W" grade (24th class day) 5:00 p.m.
April 19	Deadline (last day) to apply for May 2024 graduation via MyState with a \$50 fee plus a \$100 late

April 25 – May 1	Classes end (Tuesday/Thursday Classes: April 25) (Monday/Wednesday Classes: May 1).
April 25	Last day to withdraw for Term Two (5 class days remaining). *Please note that the tuition charges will still apply.
April 29	Deadline for graduate students receiving incomplete grades in a previous semester to submit the coursework.
May 12	Last day for May 2024 degree applicants to pay your account balance 3:00 p.m.
May 13	Final Grades Due 10:00 a.m.

\*Drop – If you choose to drop one or more classes from a specific \*term while still staying enrolled in at least one course. Dropping a course will result in a grade of "W" and tuition plus additional fees will be charged.

\*Withdrawal – If you are enrolled in a course/courses as of the first day of the \*term and you decide not to attend, you are withdrawing from the term. A withdrawal will result in a grade of "W" and a percentage if not all, tuition will be owed depending on the effective withdrawal date.

\*Term – Please be aware there are several parts of the term for the summer. Maymester, 1st 5-weeks, 2nd 5-weeks, and the 10-week term are each considered individual terms.
