## Fall Mini -Term One - 2025

All deadlines are at 12:00 midnight unless otherwise stated.

Date	Description
August 20	Classes begin.
August 22	Last day to drop or add a course (3rd class day).*
September 23	Last day to drop a course with a "W" grade (24th class day) 5:00 p.m.  *Please note that the tuition charges will still apply. *
August 25 to	Apply online via MyState for December 2025 degree - \$50 fee.
October 17	*Graduate students must be currently enrolled to apply for graduation for this semester. *
October 2	Last day to withdraw for Term One (5 class days remaining) *
October 7-8	Last regularly scheduled class day (Tuesday/Thursday Classes – October 7) (Monday/ Wednesday Classes – October 8)
October 13	Final grades due 10:00 a.m.
October 17	Deadline to apply for December 2025 degree via MyState with \$50 fee.
	*Graduate students must be currently enrolled to apply for graduation. *
October 18 –	Late December 2025 Degree Application via MyState - \$50 fee plus \$100 late application fee.
November 25	*Graduate students must be currently enrolled to apply for graduation. *
October 31	Last day for initial submission of thesis/dissertation to the Library for December graduation.
November 25	Deadline (last day) to apply for December 2025 graduation via MyState with \$50 fee plus \$100
	late application fee.
	*Graduate students must be currently enrolled to apply for graduation. *
December 3	Deadline for graduate students receiving incomplete grades in a previous semester to submit
	the coursework.
December 12	Last day for December 2025 degree applicants to pay account balance 3:00 p.m.

<sup>\*</sup>Drop – If you are choosing to drop one or more classes from a specific \*term while still staying enrolled in at least one course. Dropping a course will result in a grade of "W" and tuition plus additional fees will be charged.

<sup>\*</sup>Withdrawal – If you are enrolled in a course/courses as of the first day of the \*term and you decide not to attend, you are withdrawing from the term. A withdrawal will result in a grade of "W" and a percentage, if not all, tuition will be owed depending on the effective withdrawal date.
