Fall Mini -Term Two - 2025

All deadlines are at 12:00 midnight unless otherwise stated.

Date	Description
August 25 – October 17	Apply online via MyState for December 2025 degree - \$50 fee *Graduate students must be currently enrolled to apply for graduation for this semester. *
October 9 – 10	Fall Break – No Classes Scheduled (Dates Subject to Change)
October 13	Classes begin.
October 15	Last day to drop or add a course (3rd class day).
October 17	Deadline to apply for December 2025 degree via MyState with \$50 fee *Graduate students must be currently enrolled to apply for graduation for this semester. *
October 18 - November 25	Late December 2025 Degree Application via MyState - \$50 fee plus \$100 late application fee. *Graduate students must be currently enrolled to apply for graduation for this semester. *
November 13	Last day to drop a course with a “W” grade (24th class day) 5:00 p.m. Please note that the tuition charges will still apply. *
November 21	Last day to withdraw for Term Two (5 class days remaining). *
November 25	Deadline (last day) to apply for December 2025 graduation via myState with \$50 fee plus \$100 late application fee. *Graduate students must be currently enrolled to apply for graduation for this semester. *
November 26 - 28	Thanksgiving holiday – no classes held.
December 1 – 2	Last regularly scheduled class day (Monday/Wednesday Classes – December 1) (Tuesday/Thursday Classes – December 2) Final exams given on last class day.
December 3	Deadline for graduate students receiving incomplete grades in a previous semester to submit the
December 12	Last day for December 2025 degree applicants to pay account balance 3:00 p.m.
December 15	Final grades due 10:00 a.m.

***Drop** – If you are choosing to drop one or more classes from a specific term* while still staying enrolled in at least one course. Dropping a course will result in a grade of “W” and tuition plus additional fees will be charged.

***Withdrawal** – If you are enrolled in a course/courses as of the first day of the term* and you decide not to attend, you are withdrawing from the term. A withdrawal will result in a grade of “W” and a percentage if not all, tuition will be owed depending on the effective withdrawal date.
