Article I. Mission

The Graduate Student Association (GSA) Service and Community Outreach program aims to create and support volunteer and service opportunities on-campus and in the Starkville community for graduate students in Mississippi State University.

- 1. There will be two point allocation periods throughout the year.
- 2. Point submission periods will open at 12:00 AM of the announced day and close at11:59 PM on the deadline day as shown above.
- 3. Points do not carry-over from one semester or period to another for the purposes of maintaining active participation in the GSA

Article III. Classifications of Service and Community Outreach Activities

- 1. The Graduate Student Association will consider the following as service and community outreach activities:
 - a. Volunteer opportunities which are sponsored by the GSA
 - b. Volunteer opportunities which are sponsored by the MSU campus for which a graduate student is not receiving extra coursework credit, membership points towards another student organization, or is required service as part of a program of study
 - c. Volunteer opportunities which is available through the MSU OrgSync portal

- 1. All service and community outreach hours must be documented for accurate GSA active membership definition
 - a. Graduate student must use the OrgSync portal to confirm their participation in an event
 - b. Upon completing their service activity, graduate student must submit their activity using OrgSync
 - i. Under Involvement select Activities
 - ii. Add Involvement Entry
 - iii. Select Event Participation
 - iv. Organization select Graduate Student Association
 - v. Complete the Event Participation Form. If the event is not sponsored by the Graduate Student Association provide Reference information and proof of participation in the form of a photo of you at the event.
 - vi. Graduate students are not required to complete learning outcomes or reflections prior to submitting their involvement entry
