Deadlines

Fall 2020 Degree Application Deadline Information

August 24 – October 23:	\$50 fee
October 24-November 16:	\$50 degree audit fee and \$100 late fee
November 16:	Last day to apply for Fall 2020 degree

Important Reminders

1. All MSU grades for degree candidates must be reported to the MSU Registrar no later than 10:00 a.m. on December 1. Transfer courses taken at another institution must be reported to MSU via official transcript by December 11. A student must request that his/her transcript be sent to MSU. It is NOT automatic.

2. Account balances must be paid in full prior to final degree clearance. The payment deadline is 3:00 p.m. on November 25. Please note that fees and fines may be incurred through the end of the semester, so it is advisable to check account balances following application submission.

3. If you did not graduate in the term that you intended, you will need to re-apply for the Fall 2020 term. Degree applications DO NOT roll over each semester.

4. Students are eligible for a refund for the degree application if the application is cancelled between August 24 and October 23. After this period has ended, you will NOT receive a refund.
